INTRODUCTION

This compact flashlight produces an ultra bright light beam by using a LED powered by (2) two AA 1.5V alkaline batteries. The 2370 flashlight is designed for easy use with one hand operation and has a dual-switch mode for constant-on and momentary-on. The 2370 flashlight body is made by high precision CNC machines from aircraft-grade aluminum alloy for the most durable construction. The 2370 flashlight is water resistant.

TO INSERT BATTERIES

1. Remove the tail cap by turning counter-clockwise.
2. Install (2) two AA alkaline batteries with + terminal facing to the head assembly.
3. Replace the tail cap onto the flashlight by turning clockwise until sealed.

OPERATION

1. **MOMENTARY** - Gently depress the tail button for momentary operation.
- Press once for high, press again within a second to change from high to low

2. CONSTANT ON

1. Single Click for High Triple Click (within a second) for low
3. **LIGHT-OFF** - Press the tail button to turn OFF.

To Change the color of the light, rotate the selector ring on the light head to:

- I = white LED
- II = red LED
- III = blue LED

TO CHANGE BATTERIES

1. Remove the tail cap by turning counter-clockwise until it comes off the rear of the 2370 flashlight.
2. Remove the (2) two used batteries from the 2370 flashlight.
3. Install the (2) two new AA alkaline batteries with + terminal facing to the head assembly.
4. Replace the tail cap by turning clockwise until sealed.

GENERAL CARE AND MAINTENANCE

1. Clean o-rings with a soft clean cloth to insure that sealing area is free of dirt that could destroy the o-ring seal.
2. Apply a light coat of clear silicone grease on the o-rings occasionally if turning action becomes too difficult.
3. Remove the tail cap and wipe the rear threads of the 2370 flashlight body and inside of the tail cap with a soft clean cloth occasionally to avoid intermittent flashlight operation.

CAUTION:

To prevent the 2370 flashlight coming on accidentally when the flashlight is stored, remove the batteries. If the 2370 flashlight is turned on while it is in a container, the flashlight can overheat and damage the flashlight or the material of the surrounding area.
